We would like to thank EVERYONE who came to help and participate. We hope to take what we learned this year and use it to make Woofstock 2008 even better!

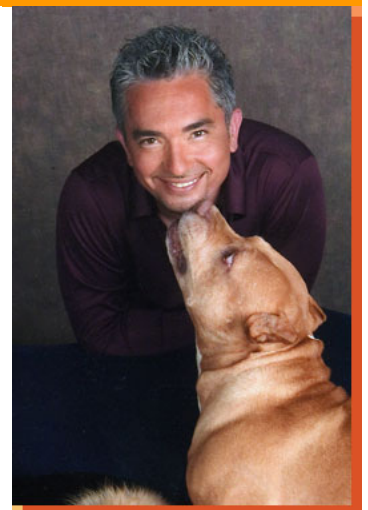
The Dog Whisperer is Coming!

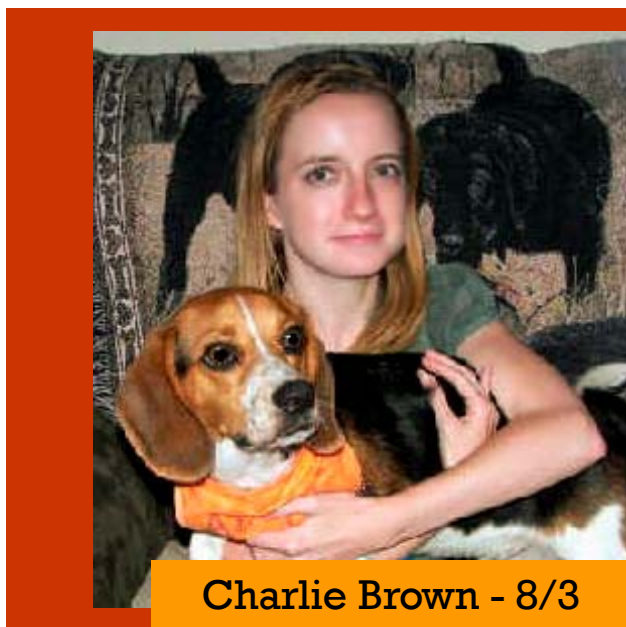
Sophie—9/8

SANDY LEIGH

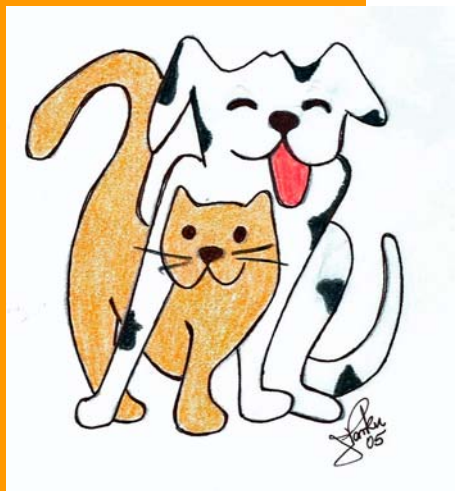

Each pet is placed in a loving foster home so he or she can be nurtured while waiting for a FURever home. It is our goal that all of our fosters be house broken, leash and crate trained prior to adoption. Every pet adopted from FFHS is microchipped and registered, receives a Rally to Rescue adoption information kit and one month of Shelter Care Pet Insurance.

We also offer spay and neuter assistance to those families in the community who cannot afford the procedure.
